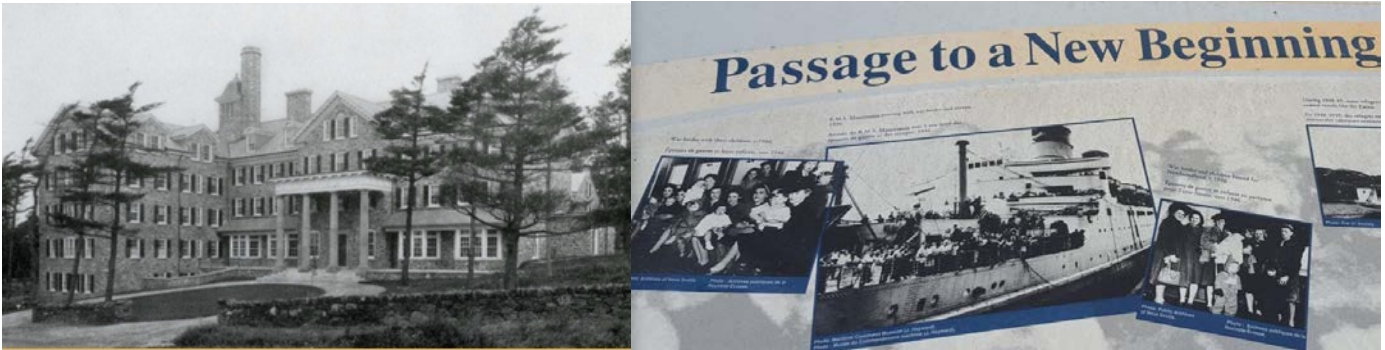

All conference sessions will be in 1108 Mona Campbell Building.

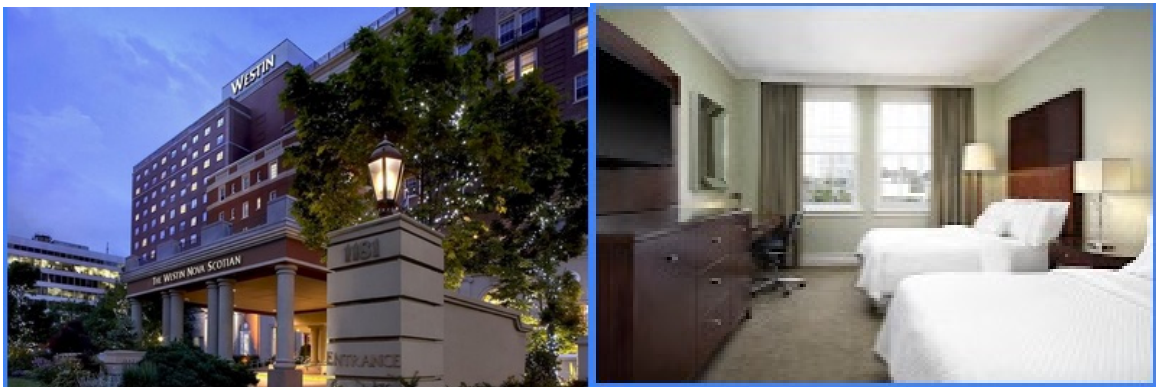

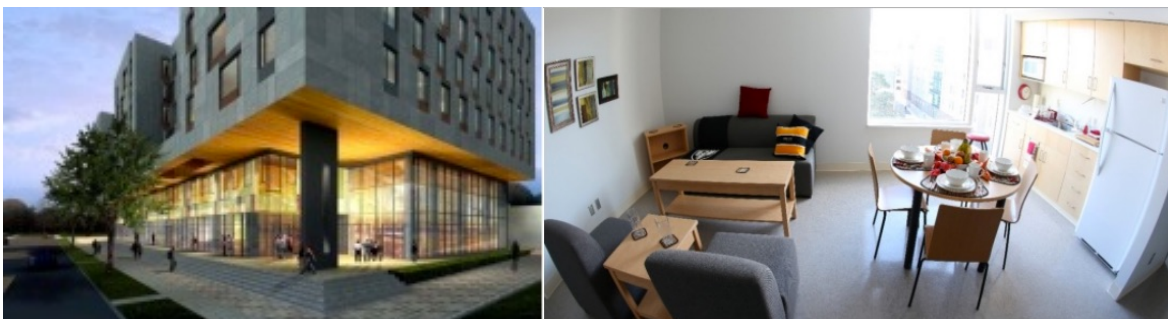
Come to the CURAC Conference, then enjoy Halifax, or all Nova Scotia
